# Fairer Funding for Devon Schools

For many years Devon has been one of the lowest-funded education authorities in England. In 2016-17 this resulted in a shortfall of £290 per pupil when compared to the national average. Other schools are funded at much higher than the national average and who therefore receive considerably more.

Just before Christmas the DfE announced the Stage 2 Consultation of this promised national funding formula for schools. We had hoped that this announcement would bring about a readjustment in funding that would benefit Devon schools given our historic underfunding. Many schools, including many primaries along with our nearby secondary schools were shocked and dismayed to find out that the result of this is a decrease in funding, resulting in significantly reduced budgets affecting the education of all children.
