Covid Update

You may be aware from the media that from Monday, schools are no longer responsible for track and trace and the NHS Test and Trace will contact people direct. For the last week we request you continue to wear masks at the start and end of the school day.

Parents and pupils are still required to report all positive tests LFD and PCR to schools as they have been. Please read the attached letter for more details.

How the Summer Reading Challenge works
