Reading to help children in hospital

Readathon is the UK's national sponsored reading event for schools. **Readathon** encourages children to read for pleasure - an activity proven to increase children's chances of success and personal happiness for the rest of their lives. *(Source: OECD)*

Readathon motivates reluctant readers to give reading a go, and keen readers to read more widely. It works because children choose what they want to read - they are not being assessed, it's all about reading for fun. We would like you to support them, in particular by sponsoring them. The money raised helps the charity Readathon to regularly give brand new books and storyteller visits to children's hospitals across the UK.
