- A girl's only sports club was run this had limited uptake.
- Team sports have been limited this year due to Covid-19 procedures.

Equality Objective 2: To continue to reduce the gender differences in attainment and attitudes to all activities.

- Due to Covid-19 no data was officially collected for summer 2020.
- Our internal analysis at Year 2 and Year 6 shows little gender difference in attainment in maths. In reading and writing at KS2, the girls' attainment is higher than the boys (greater percentage of GDS). The boys in KS1 did not attain so well in writing as the girls.
