It's been another great week in school and our new children are all settling in well. Thank you for your continued support with wearing face masks and social distancing. We know there are a number of adults and children with Covid in the locality and this all helps to reduce the risks.

Covid Reminder

Although schools are no longer responsible for track and trace we are still involved in a monitoring and supporting role when required. We still need to be informed about potential cases through Lateral Flow Tests and then the outcomes of the PCR test. Unless children are ill, or have been contacted via Track and Trace, they need to be in school.

It is really important that if children are ill, for whatever reason, they are kept away from school. If a child has been sick they must not return for 48 hours after the sickness.
