We have managed to secure an external provider to run a Beading Club after school. The Beading Club will start on Monday 7th November and run for five weeks until Monday 5th December.

Beading club is a jewellery making club that allows the children to learn a range of jewellery making skills and techniques. Each week, the children will make a wide range of jewellery using a selection of acrylic and wooden beads and assorted threads. There is a main project each week that progresses in difficulty as the term goes on, developing the child's jewellery making skills.

After making the main project of the week, the children can make as much jewellery as they like. They take home every piece of jewellery that they make. Projects range from clip on or real earrings, bracelets, necklaces, rings, hair braids, book marks and keyrings to name a few. To register and pay please visit the website below.
