Reporting Absence Procedures

No child may be released during school hours unless a request has been made to the Headteacher. If your child is absent due to illness please inform the school as soon as possible by telephone. Registers are checked and if we have not heard why a child is absent by 9.30a.m. we will ring to check for confirmation. If required, we will ring other contact numbers to ensure a child is safe. If your child is absent through illness for more than five days the school may ask for proof of absence e.g. an appointment card, prescription or Doctor's note. It is a legal requirement that the school records the reason for your child's absence. The school attendance policy is available on the school's website and in the school office.

Reading Books in Ash and Elm Class

Linked to Government guidance, schools have had to select and purchase a synthetic systematic phonics reading scheme to use in Reception and Year 1. We have selected Little Wandle Letters and Sounds and we have been lucky enough to be able to fund purchasing a new selection of reading books to support early reading. How we use and send home our reading books will change to follow the scheme.



Teachers in Ash and Elm will start implementing this new scheme next week. Please bear with us whilst we also adapt to the changes.

The children in Year 1 and 2 will have brought home a reading book this week which will be collected in on Monday and new ones given out on Wednesday.

Children in Year 2 also have an individual reading book. There will also be a selection of other books to share with your child. More detail will be provided at the information evenings.
