Autumn is definitely here now, the mornings are cooler and the weather more unpredictable, so jumpers and coats need to be brought into school.

### **Drop Off**

Please remember that children should not be arriving at school any earlier than 8.45am and that younger children must have an adult with them until the member of staff on duty comes out. A number of our older children are arriving earlier and earlier, and although I do not want to see them wandering the streets, we are unable to take responsibility for them.

### **Reading and Little Wandle (not just for KS1)**

After introducing Little Wandle, our new phonics and reading scheme in September, the children are doing really well and becoming 'super blenders'. The Little Wandle website has lots of resources to support parents. The phonics section is an area where you can listen to how each sound is pronounced to ensure your own pronunciation is correct. The useful video section includes how tricky words and blending are taught. On the books coming home tab details of the difference between the Reading Practice and the Sharing Book is clearly explained. The evidence of improved attainment across all areas of schooling (and life) has been proven to be linked to having had books read to them as well as reading books themselves. Did you know? Just one book a day for the first five years of a child's life is a massive 1800 books. These do not have to be different stories, many can be repeated, imagine the amount of language and vocabulary that involves - it is clear to see why there is such a link.
