Federation News from Mr Jolliffe

The Exe Valley Federation and Moorsway Federations have been working together since September 2023 and building a bigger and stronger group to support each other in school improvement work. On Tuesday evening the governors of both federations met to consider all the responses from the consultation, both here and in lyybridge, Shaugh Prior and Cornwood and to make a decision about the future direction of both organisations. We recognise that this is a challenging time as we continue to grow and offer support to other schools, and that changes will become necessary as this evolves. However, I am very pleased to say that, after careful consideration, thought and lots of challenging questions, both boards agreed unanimously to re-federate from 1st January 2025.

I have attached the letter from both Chairs of Governors that explains more about the decision and what will happen as we move into this new phase of collaborative working. As a result of re-federation, we will need to elect two new parent governors and there is more information about this opportunity below.
