Hopefully, you all had a good half term and have benefitted from the recent weather, although I appreciate hayfever sufferers are having a tough time at present.

It has been a challenging week with many issues with our internet connection and speed. If you need to promptly inform us of something important, for example, a change to the adult collecting or an impending appointment, we would always recommend you phone the office rather than email.

Staff have been busy organising school trips and these will all take place in July. All venues chosen are closed to the general public on the dates selected to help to continue to ensure we all stay well. The PTA are kindly helping to subsidise the cost of the coaches and letters with more details will be sent home shortly. A SOE3 form also needs completing and returning before we can take your child on any trip and these will be enclosed with the letters.

Important reminders:

- The morning drop off now runs with amazing fluency so we will return to the traditional pre-Covid drop off time of **8.50am**. No responsibility can be taken for children arriving at school before 8.50 am and children should not be left unaccompanied in the playground before this time. Please queue if necessary, rather than all crowd in the playground to help reduce contacts. We need to ensure an adult is available in class before we send children in and occasionally a problem has arisen to prevent this.
- Collection time will continue to be 3.20pm for KS1 and 3.30pm for KS2.
- Hats and sun cream now the weather is improving please apply sun cream to your child before coming into school and provide a sun hat. Children can bring in sun cream in their bags (labelled) to apply themselves at lunchtime if required. Now children are removing their jumpers more, please ensure they are named they end up all over the place!

Please be considerate of others and refrain from standing around the school gates with your dogs - regardless of their shape or size, we have a number of children that are scared of them and we do not want any issues children and vehicles.
