School Meals

The price of our school meals has been static, at £2.30, for over seven years. After careful consideration we have decided we have to increase the price of paid school meals to £2.50 with



effect from 23rd April (first day of the summer term). This is linked to increased food and fuel costs that we have been experiencing over the past few years. To date we have not passed any of this increase on to the parents, but we are no longer covering the school's costs of providing the meals.

There will continue to be no charge for meals for those in KS1 and those who are eligible for a free meal.
