After School Sports Provision

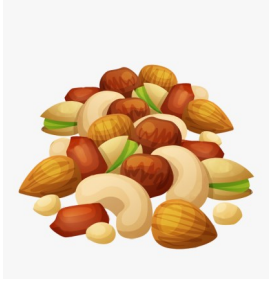
We are delighted to be able to offer some extra-curricular activities, with Sporty Stars, starting after half term. This will be different to in previous years, to ensure that all activities are in line with Covid regulations and so that the sessions match the logistics currently in place in school. Here is how the sessions will run:

Each class bubble have been allocated a day per week, where they will take part in a multi-activity club. The group will take some ownership of the content and games covered and Sporty Stars will be managing the resources and equipment used each week. This will be sanitised and quarantined appropriately. Your child will not change for the club and where possible, all sessions will run outside in the playground. If weather is particularly inclement, the children will be taken into their usual classroom; no sessions will run in the hall.

The clubs will run from 3.30pm - 4.45pm and all children will need to be collected using the one way system, as per normal pick up, (unless you wish your child to walk home and have signed the relevant paperwork—although with the clocks changing soon remember evenings will be darker).

We are working hard to ensure that all children have access to high quality sporting provision to promote physical activity; please feel free to ask if you have any questions and we appreciate you following the usual pick up guidelines to keep everyone safe.

The site 'Omegle' is a Cam Chat site that is aimed at adults 18+ and promotes itself as a site where you can chat to random strangers. In reality adults seem to go there to interact with strangers in a sexual way.
