Support with Easter Holiday Activities

Free activities with healthy meals will be available to children from low income families during the Easter holidays. Devon County Council is arranging the activity programme, working with providers in locations across Devon. It's part of a national, Government-funded initiative to provide free activities and healthy meals during the Easter, Summer and Christmas holidays 2021, and children of all abilities, aged between the ages 0 to 18, can attend.

Places are open now for children from low income families, including those eligible for free school meals, during the Easter holidays. Other children that are not eligible may be able to purchase places if the provider has the capacity to accommodate them.
