

Annual Equality Objectives Review (From Equality Policy June 2019)

Equality Objective 1: To increase participation for girls in sport.

- Mixed gender races were offered at sports day alongside boys and girls races.
- Girls were picked equally with boys for any sporting event held away from school, e.g. athletics, tag rugby

Equality Objective 2: To continue to reduce the gender differences in attainment and attitudes to all activities.

- Boys and girls have similar progress and attainment scores at Year 6. (July 2019)

Equality Objective 3: To create a greater awareness of Modern British Values as part of our diverse culture.

- Responsibility focus for Autumn first half/Respect for second half linked to learning certificates.
- Use of Jigsaw scheme - links to ensuring people feel welcome in our society and how our behaviour affects others.

Equality Objective 4: To create a greater awareness of different forms of disability through assemblies and through the curriculum.

- 23 Year 6 achieved the Torbay and Devon Civic Award. Charities supported and promoted included Bristol Children's Hospital, Children In Need, Cancer Research, Marie Curie, Dementia Café.
- Ash Class had sessions on cerebral palsy.
