Year 6 SATs Scores 2017

This is the second year of the new testing regime for Key Stage 2 SATs. Our Year 6 cohort for 2017 is 18 children, so each child is worth 5.5%.

There is a 'scaled score' system, which works on the idea that 100 is expected attainment for end of Year 6, ranging from 80 to 120.
