Trip to Knighthayes

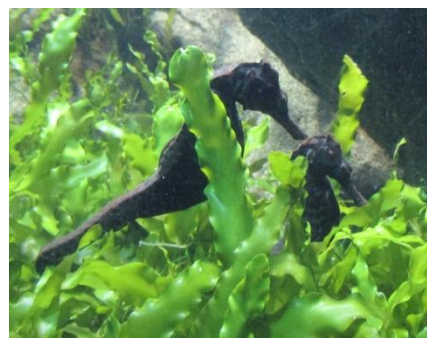
