- Purchase a portable sink for Elm Class
- Supply and fit our Apple signs and windows
- Part fund the building of the new outdoor shelter to support our Early Years
- Support for Year 6 leavers event at the Cricket Club

Throughout the last school year we worked with the Skills Builder Partnership. The scheme supports essential skills which link closely to our 6Rs.


Our 6Rs are known as the Whimple Wonders and have named Apple Characters
