#### **Reports and Parent Consultations**

Schools have a statutory requirement to provide parents with an annual report for each child at some point in the school year.

Included in this report there will details about your child's achievements in all subjects and activities forming part of the school curriculum, highlighting strengths and areas for development.

Comments on general progress are also included along with the pupil's attendance record from April 2021 until February half term 2022. Usually this would be a whole school year but schools were in a lockdown period for most of the spring term 2021 so this has not been included.

The reports are very comprehensive and if a teacher would like to speak with you regarding particular aspects of the report, a letter will be in the envelope requesting that you make an appointment. Parents also have the option of requesting an appointment if the report brings up any concerns or queries. Bookings for these meetings will via the ESchools Login accessible via our main school website.

At relevant points in the summer term, the results of any official assessments taken, will be sent out, (phonics screening, Key Stage 1 and 2 SATs, multiplication check).

Reports for children will be towards the end of the summer term as reporting has to be linked to the statements. Parents of children in Reception are invited to make an appointment
