valuable life skills. All children in Year 1 to Year 6 take part in blocked activities held on Friday afternoons. This year we have adjusted the mix of activities slightly allowing us to take part in a number of community projects. Our first is a quilting project with the Year 6 children, in conjunction with Killerton.

imbalance in numbers, the children in Year 1 and 2 will be placed into two mixed groups. These groups will stay the same for blocks of two activities, so children participating in Forest Schools this time will then do Relax Kids/Computing, and vice versa. For the next two activity blocks after that, the children will be 're-mixed'.

If you, or you know of any adults in the village who would like to support us with these activities, particularly crafting and cookery, do get in touch. Each block of activities are for 4 weeks at a time so the time commitment could be for as little as one block. Our next crafting group will be knitting and crocheting poppies to display in the church, so if you have these skills and want to pass them on, come and have a go. (All adults will need to have a DBS check first). In cookery, it is the older children first and we are hoping to try and make a selection of meals and hold a taster session with parents at the end.

Reception Children Pickup

Our new children have settled in really well. They stay for lunch from Wednesday onwards, which will be the next exciting chapter for them. Children need to be collected at 1.30pm - please do not come into school (via the main blue gates) until after 1.20pm so we can ensure that all the children have returned to class after lunch. If you can wait in the lower playground opposite the class but back towards the main building, this will enable other children going to assembly to get past safely.
