Happy New Year! Hopefully, you have all managed to do something pleasant over the Christmas break.



I don't know about you, but I can't believe we are now in 2022. For some of us, (me included), it does not seem so long ago that we were worrying about moving into a new millennia and that all the computers may stop working! Imagine that now - everything would cease and we wouldn't be able to do many of the things we do at the moment - no Xbox or Netflix?!

It's strange how things now change so rapidly, especially in current times with having to keep up with current testing procedures and rules to try to keep us all safe.

It has been lovely for the staff to see all the children return to school after a disruptive last few weeks of term.

### **Recent guidelines now states:**

Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result are to be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January. This will mean that anyone who receives a positive LFD test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test.

If someone is feeling well, a lateral flow test can be taken on day 6 and 7 after the positive test. If you receive negative LFD results on day 6 and day 7 of your self-isolation period - with tests taken 24 hours apart - you will no longer have to self-isolate for the full 10 days. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period.

### **What we still need you to inform the school office:**

- positive LFD test result with the date of the test
- dates of the two negative LFD tests
- date your child will be returning to school

Schools are still responsible for reporting cases and the outcome of tests as this helps to inform future guidance.

If a child is well and self-isolating, school will provide work for home learning from the day after notification. For the first day please continue to refer to the website:

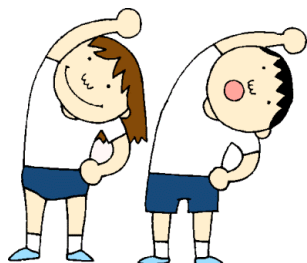
