Morning Drop Off

Please remember that just after 9am the top gate is locked and any children arriving after this time need to be brought in via the blue gates which are always unlocked. (Even though they do not look like it). If a member of staff is not seen on entry, you **must** bring your child to the school office and sign them so we can add them to the register and know they are on the school site.

Bikeability - week commencing 11th October

Just a brief reminder that our Year 6 children are having cycling lessons in order to help them to develop their road skills and to support them to ride safely and considerately. These children will need to bring their bikes to school all week.

Please can we ask that all other children DO NOT bring bikes or scooters to school that week so we have enough space to store all the bicycles safely.

Parent Consultations

These will be bookable on ESchools App and are available to view from 4pm with booking from 1pm Saturday to enable everyone new the opportunity to log in to the system.

Most consultations will be in the village hall during school hours (so please go direct to the main doors of the hall and not into school) and then move into the main school building.

The exceptions are Willow and Ash Consultations taking place on the Monday/Wednesday where you will need to come to the school office to book in.

For after school appointments please either wait outside or go through the double doors and wait in the library. Signs will be visible for those unfamiliar with the school site.

All new children have been given log in information for ESchools this week. If you already have a child in school you will not need separate logins for each child. They should all appear when you log in as a parent.
