## PE Sports Premium Funding Academic year 2015-2016

In addition to the Sports Premium spending Clyst Vale Learning Community fund a program of sporting activities which aims to give children opportunities beyond individual schools. This comes in two strands:

1. Year groups and classes are taken for different workshops at Clyst Vale to develop ball skills, racket skills etc.
2. Gifted and talented sessions are run for more targeted development. Additional costs to transport children to sporting activities will be met out of the school fund.
