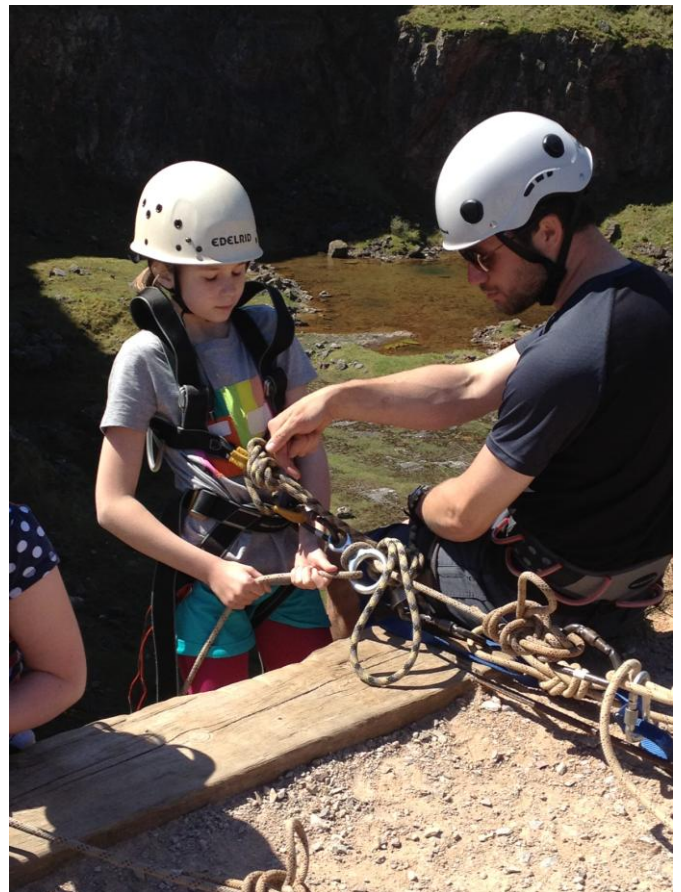


Granville House 2012

Despite the awful weather of the summer term we had fantastic weather as we headed off to Brixham for our residential trip

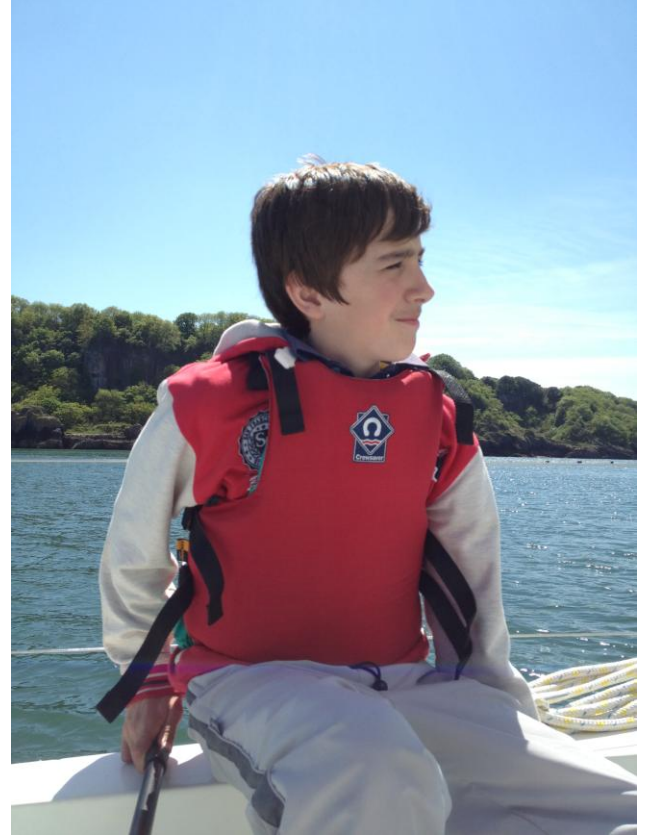


After settling in it was straight on with the activities. The abseiling was a real challenge!

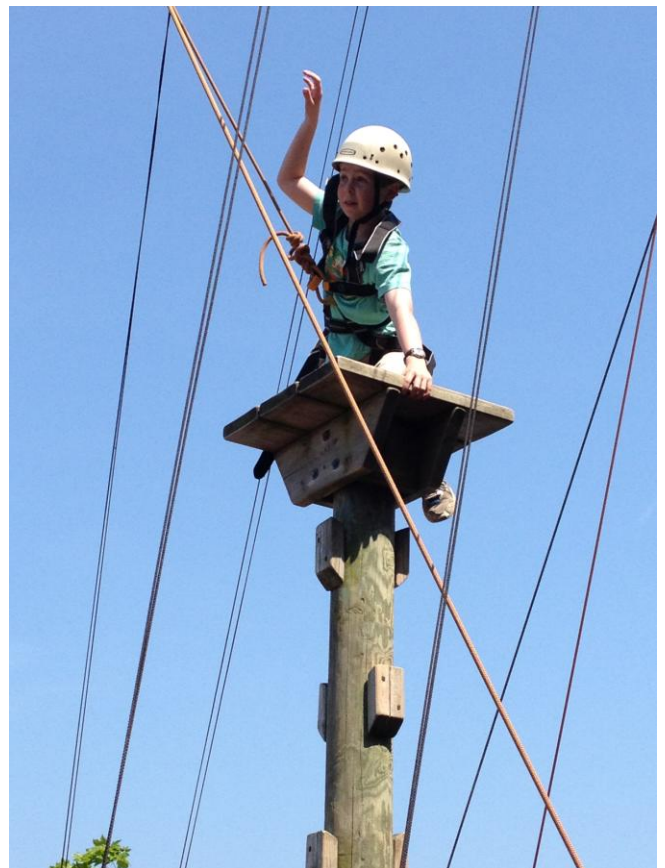




We really enjoyed the sailing

of the helmets and harnesses.





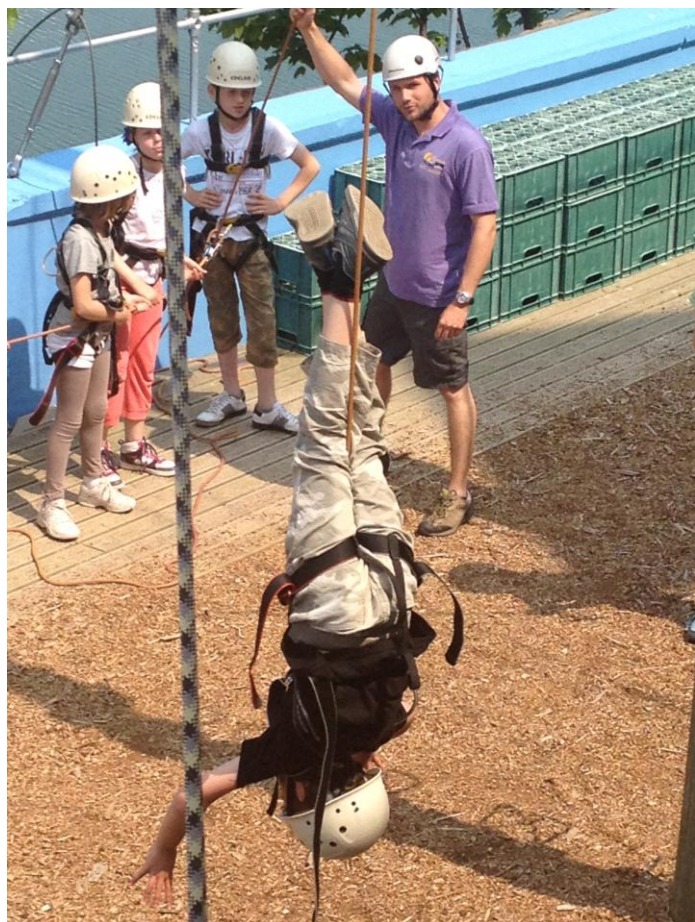
We had to keep the safety rope tight and take the weight.

work!



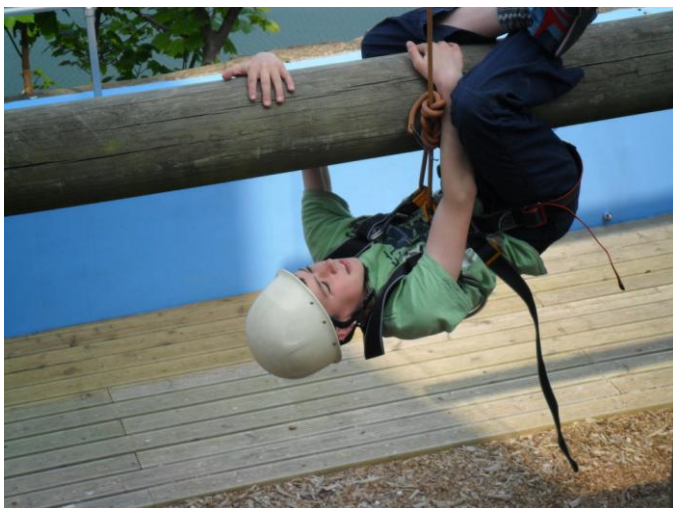


Every morning we had to make our own breakfast and packed lunch. We had to be responsible for remembering everything we needed for the day.
