Pick Up Time for Reception

Dogs

Dogs are not permitted on school property (not even in the arms of an adult). We continue to have a number of children that are fearful of dogs and have to walk home so please stay away from the pavement outside of the gates and railings - please arrange to meet your children a short distance away.

Packed Lunches and Snacks

We continue to encourage healthy snacks for children at school. We have a **NO NUTS** policy in school as we have a number of children with significant allergies, this includes ALL NUTS and NUT products not just peanuts. It is surprising just how many snack bars contain nuts, so please can we ask you all to check ingredients listings before sending any in, instead of making the assumption that it wouldn't contain them.

All school dinners, including universal free school meals for reception, year 1 and year 2, should now be ordered online with School Gateway. Please make sure you order meals in advance. If you are unsure or need any assistance please call into the office.

Drop Off and Collection

Thank you for continuing to follow our one way system from the hall car park. Parents with pushchairs/buggies are able to come in through the main blue gates, there is no need to negotiate the steps.

The Thirsty Farmer kindly allows our parents to park in their car park for drop off and collection. The village hall car park is for staff and for patients and staff of the doctors surgery.
