#### **Federation News from Mr Jolliffe**

The consultation period for the proposed re-federation between Exe Valley and Moorsway closed today and the questions that parents and other members of the school stakeholder groups have asked are on the updated consultation document, along with the answers. The full governing boards of both federations will take into account the feedback from parents from the consultation when they make their final decision on Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> November. I will let you know what the outcome of the meeting is at the end of that week. This term, we have been working with senior leaders and teachers in the South Hams federation as well, which gives us more capacity to work more intensely with the Moorsway schools and governors are exploring the possibility of a more formal collaborative arrangement with this group of schools next year.

### **YEAR 3 and 4 RESIDENTIAL VISIT PAYMENTS**

The Year 3 and 4 residential visit is planned for Wednesday, 30<sup>th</sup> April to Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2025 and we will be going by train from Crediton to the YHA at Okehampton. Silverton, Thorverton and Whimple will be going away for Wednesday and Thursday including Wednesday night; Cheriton Fitzpaine, Sandford, Newton St Cyres and Brampford Speke will be going for Thursday and Friday including Thursday night. We are still finalising the activity plan for the two year groups who are going and are waiting for confirmation of the cost. The visit is likely to cost around £110 for the two days, including activities, travel and accommodation. We appreciate that this is a significant outlay for parents so there will be a phased payment system set up on School Gateway for parents to start making payments of £20 each month towards the cost. We will confirm the price for the visit as soon as we can and let parents know.
