Activity Passports

At Whimble Primary we have always prided ourselves on our broad and balanced curriculum.

Last year, for the first time, our Year 6 children partook in the Devon and Torbay Civic Award which involved a variety of activities throughout the year. All the children achieved the award which was presented at a special evening involving children and parents from a number of schools.

The activities involved, demonstrated and reinforced the value of having a wide range of hobbies and interests.

There are a number of activity type ideas around including one from the DfE and National Trust.

The development of hobbies and skills links brilliantly with our school vision and values, especially our 6Rs - Responsibility, Respect, Resourcefulness, Reasoning, Reflection, and Resilience. On Thursday 16th January there is a change to the usual menu as this is our census day. Our funding for Universal Free School Meals (ie our free meals in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) is calculated from the number of meals taken on that day.

The more children having a school meal on that day means we are given more money in our budget. This helps us considerably as our meals, paid or otherwise, cost us more than we are given per unit due to other costs of providing the meals, e.g transport. We already use school fund money to compensate for the difference, so the smaller this gap is, the better.
