#### **Federation News from Mr Jolliffe**

Next Tuesday is Internet Safety Day and we will have the opportunity during next week to talk to the children about how they can stay safe on line, both at school and at home. When it comes to keeping children safe online at home, that is when we really need your help, and there are some useful guides on the Exe Valley Federation website about how to do this. We have added some more information about the risks to children connected to the growth of artificial intelligence and some guidance on how to manage screen time effectively. These can be tricky areas of parenting to navigate but I hope the information that we have shared with you might be helpful as well. Most of the time children use the amazing resources available to them on-line, safely and there are good systems in place to prevent them coming to harm. The guides on the federation website also give you some guidance about the signs that children might be facing a safeguarding issue and where you can go to get help. The key message is to able to talk to your child about on-line safety and to be aware of what they are accessing via any device, including those belonging to other family members. If you do want further advice, please do contact your child's Head of School, who is also their Designated Safeguarding Lead.

Winter-themed crafts


